He gained remarkable experience in technology and technological innovation in industrial environments. He is an expert in transport and renewable energy. He has directed many research projects regarding energy and transport.

The managerial experience he has acquired in many industrial companies has enabled him to work as a consultant and advisor in technological and managerial areas; during his career, he has started many industrial initiatives in renewable sources (Eurosolare, ANIT) and transportation (Infomobility, SMC esercizio)

He was one of the founders of the European Association of Photovoltaic Companies and founded the Italian Association of Photovoltaic Industries, where he gained experience in industrial confederations.

He was Mobility Manager for the City of Parma and helped draw up some city traffic plans.

He contributed to the opening of new mobility initiatives, including car-sharing, in many Italian cities (Genoa, Brescia, province of Milan).

His experience in the energy field has enabled him to develop projects for the use of electric cars on a car-sharing basis (Palermo 2000), to cooperate to the ICBI Project for the conversion of buses to methane and to start a plan for the use of ethanol-fuelled buses in La Spezia.
